The Idaho Malting Barley Field Short Course will give participants a first-hand opportunity to see our 2014 malting barley crop, discuss new variety developments and malt quality issues and visit a commercial malting facility in Pocatello (Great Western Malting / Country Malt).

## Idaho Malting Barley Field Course Itinerary

**Monday, July 14** - Participants should arrive in Idaho Falls by 2 p.m.

**Tour malting barley fields** from Idaho Falls (4,600 ft. elevation) to the higher elevation Teton region (6,000 ft.). Bus transportation provided.

Visit **University of Idaho Tetonia Research Farm** for 1 ½ hour classroom discussion on barley breeding for yield and malting quality and Idaho barley agronomics and sustainability, featuring USDA ARS and University of Idaho scientists and Great Western Malting barley field managers.

**Barbecue dinner at Grand Teton Brewing Co. in Victor, ID.** Hosted by Brew Master Rob Mullin and *co-sponsored by the Brewers Association*. Return to Idaho Falls for overnight stay at Idaho Falls Airport Hampton Inn, Airport, 208-523-1400. **Craft Brewers Rate: \$99/night.**

**Tuesday, July 15** - Depart Idaho Falls for Pocatello (55 minute drive west). **Tour Great Western Malting plant.** Lunch in Pocatello area hosted by Great Western Malting Co.

**Afternoon Options:** Return to Idaho Falls or travel to Burley (one hour drive west) for winter malting barley harvest and tour MillerCoors barley research & development center (**tentative**). Return to Idaho Falls in evening.
