The IBC board set its Fiscal Year 2013 budget at its annual budget meeting held in Buhl and Twin Falls on May 23-24.

The board approved a preliminary budget of **\$473,545, which represents a 5.6% increase from this year.** Income is projected to increase to \$454,255, due to increased plantings, a 15% increase from 2011/12.

**Here is a FY 2013 expense breakdown:**

Admin - 18%  
Research - 27%  
Market Dev - 21.5%  
Grower Services— 22.5%  
Info/Edu - 11%.
